Parts Exchange — buyer terms (pilot)

B2B marketplace for automotive parts. Listings are trade-to-trade unless a listing says otherwise. ACL consumer guarantees may still apply if you are a consumer — confirm with counsel. Platform is not the supplier of the part unless counsel later says otherwise.

- Delayed seller payout is not legal escrow (API claim legalEscrow=false).
- Courier is stub. Do not rely on live tracking.
- Used / recycled parts must be as described. Fitment is the buyer's check.
- RMA path is the returns panel. Dispute pack is ops-exported.
